## Publication Agreement

This is a publication agreement (“this agreement”) regarding a written manuscript currently entitled \_\_\_\_\_, (“the article”) to be published in the LatinX in AI (LXAI) Research Journal as either a conference workshop proceedings, an extended abstract, a full journal article, or a collection of research data.

The parties to this Agreement are: \_\_\_\_\_, (name of corresponding author who signs on behalf of any other authors, collectively “you”), and the LatinX in AI (LXAI) Research Journal (“the publisher”).

1. By signing this form, you warrant that you are signing on behalf of all authors of the article, and that you have the authority to act as their agent for the purpose of entering into this Agreement.

2. **Author Representations.** You further warrant that:

(a) The article is original, has not been formally published in any other peer reviewed journal or in a book or edited collection, and is not under consideration for any such Publication.

(b) You are the sole author(s) of the article, and that you have a complete and unencumbered right to make the grants you make.

(c) The article does not libel anyone, invade anyone's copyright or otherwise violate any statutory or common law right of anyone, and that you have made all reasonable efforts to ensure the accuracy of any factual information contained in the article. You agree to indemnify the publisher against any claim or action alleging facts which, if true, constitute a breach of any of the foregoing warranties or other provisions of this agreement, as well as against any related damages, losses, liabilities, and expenses incurred by the publisher.

3. **Creative Commons License.** You hereby grant a Creative Commons copyright license in the article to the general public, in particular a Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International License, which is incorporated herein by reference and is further specified at <http://creativecommons.org/licenses/by/4.0/legalcode> (human readable summary at <http://creativecommons.org/licenses/by/4.0>).

4. **License of publishing rights.** You agree to require that a citation to the original publication of the article in the proceedings as well as a hyperlink to the LatinX in AI (LXAI) Research

Journal web site linking to the original paper be included in any attribution statement satisfying the attribution requirement of the Creative Commons license of paragraph 2.

**5. Scholarly communication rights.** I understand that I retain the copyright in the Article and that no rights in patents, trademarks or other intellectual property rights are transferred to the Publisher. As the author of the Article, I understand that I shall have the same rights to reuse the Article as those allowed to third party users (and the Publisher) of the Article under the CC BY License.

**6. Research Data.** “Research Data” shall mean the result of observations or experimentation that validate research findings and that are published separate to the Article, which can include but are not limited to raw data, processed data, software, algorithms, protocols and methods. With respect to any Research Data that I wish to make accessible on a site or through a service of Journal Owner, Journal Owner shall have a perpetual worldwide, non-exclusive right and license to publish, extract, reformat, adapt, build upon, index, redistribute, link to and otherwise use all or any part of the Research Data in all forms and media (whether now known or later developed), and permit others to do so. Where I have selected a specific end user license under which the Research Data is to be made available on a site or through a service, the publisher shall apply that end user license to the Research Data on that site or service.

**6. Supplemental Materials.** “Supplemental Materials” shall mean materials published as a supplemental part of the Article, including but not limited to graphical, illustrative, video and audio material. With respect to any Supplemental Materials that I submit, Journal Owner shall have a perpetual worldwide, non-exclusive right and license to publish, extract, reformat, adapt, build upon, index, redistribute, link to and otherwise use all or any part of the Supplemental Materials, in all forms and media (whether now known or later developed) and permit others to do so. The publisher shall apply the same end user license to the Supplemental Materials as to the Article where it publishes the Supplemental Materials with the Article in the journal on its online platforms on an Open Access basis.

**6. Revision Rights.** To the extent that any edits made by the publisher to make the article suitable for publication in the proceedings amount to copyrightable works of authorship, the publisher hereby assigns all right, title, and interest in such edits to you. The publisher agrees to verify with you any such edits that are substantive. You agree that the license of paragraph 2 covers such edits.

**7. Governing Law, Jurisdiction, and Addenda.** This is the entire agreement between you and the publisher, and it may be modified only in writing. It will be governed by the laws of the jurisdiction of the Federal District Court for the District of Alameda, San Francisco, California, where LatinX in AI (LXAI) Org. is located. It will bind and benefit our respective assigns and successors in interest, including your heirs. It will terminate if the publisher does not publish, in any medium, the article within one year of the date of your signature.

**8. Publication Rights.** You also agree that LatinX in AI (LXAI) may print, sell, and distribute the work, and post the work on the LatinX in AI (LXAI) web pages.
